San José Clinic provides quality healthcare and education to those with limited access to such services.



Clinic services are available to low-income, uninsured people living in the city of Houston and surrounding areas. Patients pay a minimum fee for Clinic services. The fee is based on a sliding scale, determined by the Federal Poverty Guidelines, which account for family size and income.

1) ELIGIBILITY INTERVIEW

Eligibility interviews are available Monday—Friday on a walk-in basis from 8 am—3 pm.

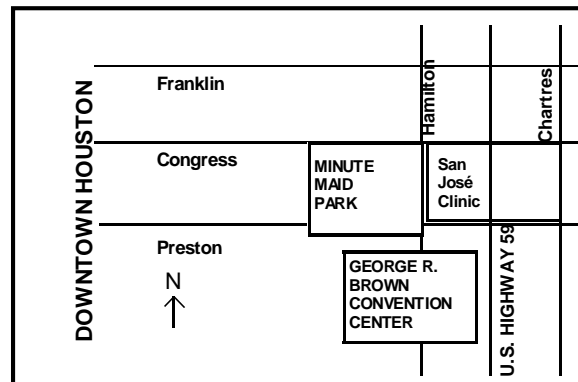
3) APPOINTMENTS ARE LIMITED— Please call if you are unable to keep your appointment.

ELIGIBILITY INTERVIEW

When coming for an eligibility interview we require the following documents for each family applying for services:

1) IDENTIFICATION

Adult—bring one of the following for each adult (ID must include a photo):

- Texas Driver’s License
- Texas Identification card (current or expired)
- Passport or Visa
- U.S. Immigration documents
- ID from other country

Child—bring one of the following for each child:

- Birth Certificate
- Birth Fact Record

Note: A Social Security card is not required; however please bring one for each family member that has one.

2) PROOF OF INCOME

Bring as many of these documents as you have.

- Last 4 paycheck stubs (or 2 stubs if paid bi-weekly)
- Welfare benefit documents (TANF and Food Stamps)
- SSI or Social Security certification documents
- Unemployment documentation
- Child Support
- Most recent tax return

3) PROOF OF ADDRESS

Documentation showing where you have lived for the past month.

Examples: Lease, Medicaid document, house payment, voter registration, utility bill, 2 pieces of valid mail in your name with current address
